Recorder Speaks to Buckeye Boys State Delegates

During the last two Sundays Columbiana County Recorder Craig Brown has spent part of his afternoon speaking to area high school students at Glenmoore and Steubenville whom were selected to attend the Ohio American Legion's Buckeye Boys State.

Brown said, "It is a great honor to congratulate these young men on what may be a great moment in their lives."

During his speeches Brown credited his own political involvement to his own selection to Buckeye Boys State in 1994.

At Buckeye Boys State Brown said he served as director of communications for the attorney general, city party chairman, and county party chairman.
